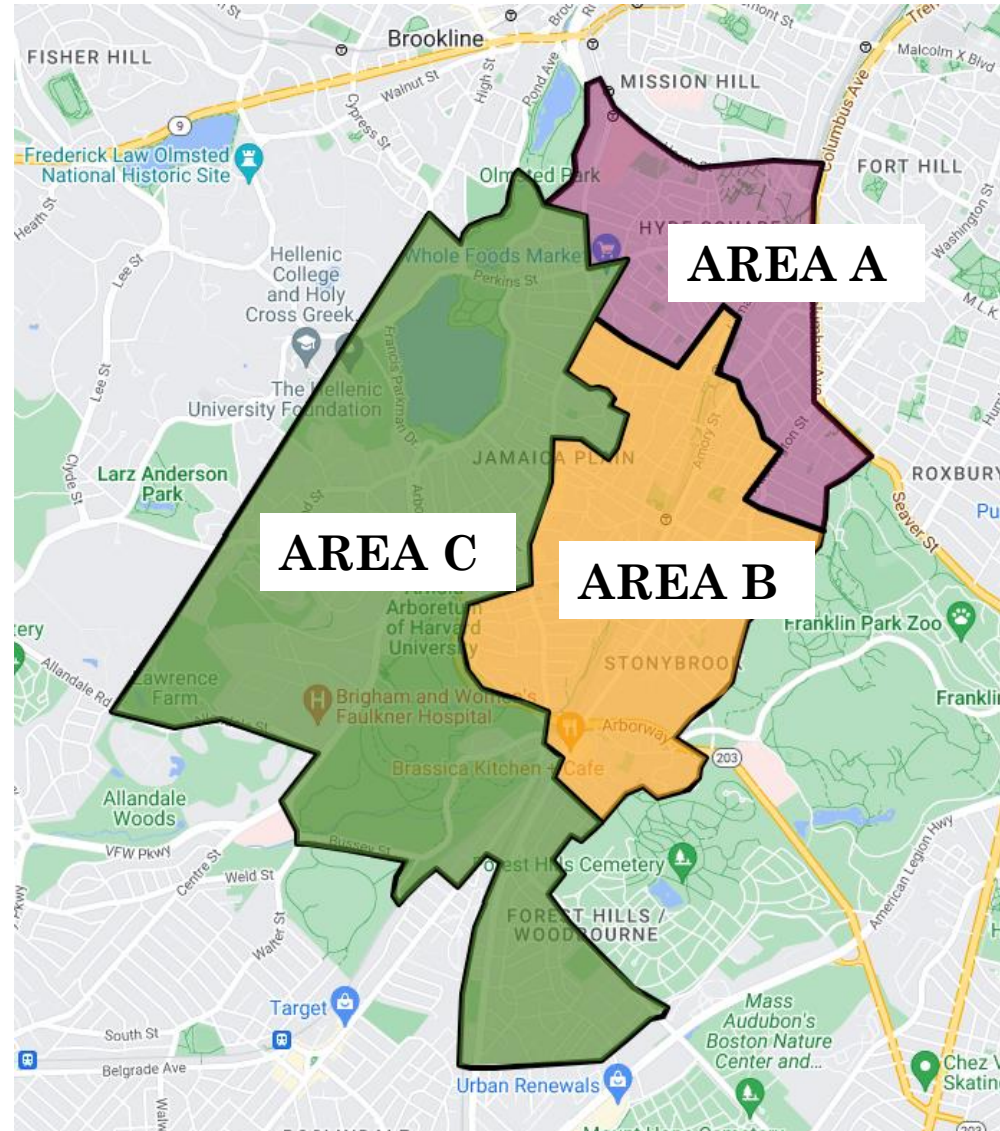


JPNC 101

Council Structure

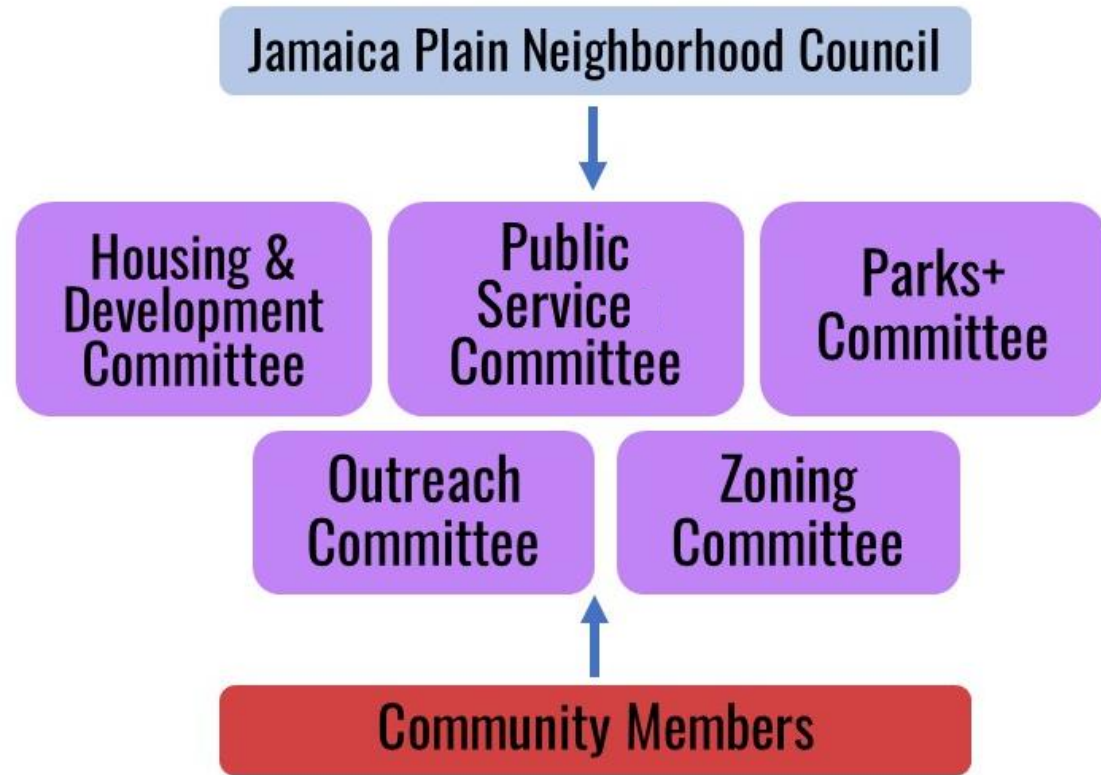
- Founded in 1985 to strengthen the community's opportunity to participate directly and fully in governing neighborhood affairs.
- 20 volunteers elected to the council that represent 3 geographic areas of JP
 - 5 At Large Council Members
 - 5 Area A Council Members
 - 5 Area B Council Members
 - 5 Area C Council Members
- Elections every 2 years – no term limit

Council Structure

- 5 committees comprised of both council members and community members
 - Each committee can have up to 5 council members and 10 community members.
- Committees meet at least once per month to discuss matters specific to that committee role.
- Full council meets monthly to understand what was discussed at the committee meetings, and also hear from elected officials or other groups affiliated with relevant projects.
- Committees often request votes from the full council.
- Anyone can attend any meeting and anyone can join a committee!



Council Functions

- Involvement in community development at all levels, from large developments to small zoning variances.
- Vote on issuance of permits/licenses related to commercial operations, such as outdoor patios and beer/wine licenses.
- Facilitate communication between community members and governing officials.
- Influence policy in the community and local government.
- Advocate for the needs and wants of community members
- Foster a sense of community between JP residents through attendance at community events.

- **Responsibilities:**
 - Provide a community forum for information and discussion around JP development projects while they are in the early planning phases.
 - Review developers' adherence to JPNC guidelines in the areas of inclusionary zoning and transportation-oriented development

Public Service

- **Chair: Michael Reiskind**
- **Responsibilities**
 - Review requests for food service, alcohol, and entertainment licensing, and making recommendations to the appropriate licensing board or committee
 - Work with utilities and city departments to address a range of public safety and public service issues
 - Partner with the Boston Police and local crime watch groups to promote safety and tackle crime-related problems.

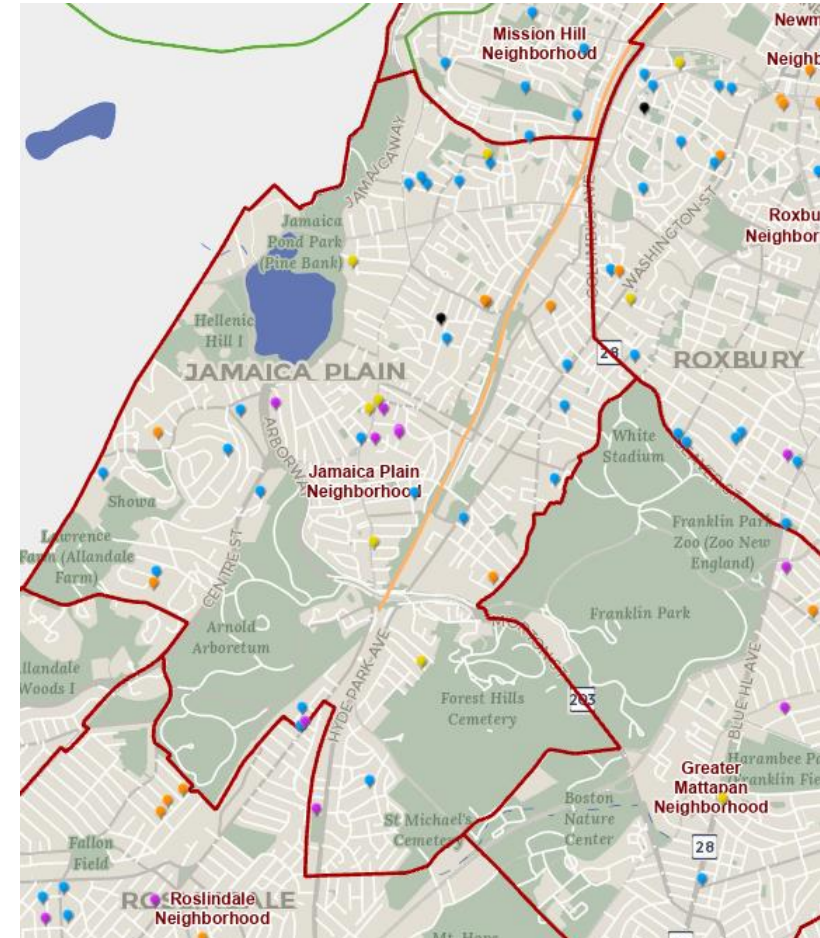
Parks+
